## Lawrence Bishnoi Gang – Extortion Letter To Abbotsford Police Department Boasting 1,000+ Gunmen

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The India-based Lawrence Bishnoi Gang (designated a terrorist entity by Canada in September 2025) delivered a formal extortion letter to the Abbotsford Police Department on 13 August 2025 explicitly claiming an operational cadre of “**upwards of 1,000 individuals willing to carry out these shootings.**” The letter framed the gang’s criminal enterprise as a **systematic “tax” protection racket targeting businesses.** Details surfaced publicly 28 May 2026, during

testimony by Edmonton Police Service Const. Kevin St. Louis (Project AI-Extortion) at an Immigration and Refugee Board deportation hearing.

This incident is part of a sustained transnational extortion-and-violence campaign against South Asian (primarily Punjabi/Sikh) business owners across British Columbia, Alberta, Ontario, and Manitoba. **Recruits are overwhelmingly recent temporary foreign workers or international students** contacted via encrypted apps. Internal fractures (e.g., rift with associate Goldy Brar) have increased operational chaos and copycat activity, while RCMP reporting notes **selective state-linked actions on behalf of the Indian government in cases of transnational repression.**

**Client Impact | Immediate elevated risk** to South Asian-owned SMEs, logistics, construction, hospitality, cultural/religious sites, and any critical infrastructure with diaspora supply-chain exposure.

## **INCIDENT DETAILS**

- **Letter Delivery**| 13 August 2025 to Abbotsford Police Department (confirmed by Sgt. Paul Walker, Operation Community Shield).
- **Key Content**| Organizational outline boasting “upwards of 1,000 foot soldiers” available for shootings; explicit monetary motive (“every business needs to pay their tax”).
- **Revelation**| 28 May 2026 – Testimony in deportation hearing for alleged Edmonton-based member Jashandeep Singh (linked to Surrey shooting).

## **THREAT ACTOR PROFILE – LAWRENCE BISHNOI GANG**

- **Leadership** | **Lawrence Bishnoi** (jailed in India since 2015; directs via proxies). Primary Canadian communicator identified as Jora Sidhu (voice-matched by RCMP; believed operating offshore).

- **Canadian Footprint** | Active in BC, Alberta, Ontario; exploits local recruits on temporary visas for low-cost, high-volume operations.
- **Designations** | Listed as terrorist entity under Canada's *Criminal Code* (Sep 2025) for murder, shootings, arson, and intimidation creating a climate of insecurity.
- **Geopolitical Overlay** | RCMP national security reporting indicates the gang acts on behalf of the Indian government in select transnational repression cases.
- **Internal Dynamics** | Major rift with former lieutenant Goldy Brar (late 2025) has produced more disorganized, direct-action shootings without prior demands.

## MODUS OPERANDI & CAPABILITIES

- **Extortion Flow** | Unsolicited WhatsApp demands referencing "Bishnoi" or "Goldy Brar" → non-payment triggers drive-by shootings at residences or businesses.
- **Firearms & Mobility** | Rapid inter-provincial weapon movement complicates tracing.
- **Recruitment** | Targets new immigrants seeking belonging; minimal payment with "sense of community" inducement.
- **Scale** | Claimed 1,000+ shooters; real-world violence documented in Peel Region, Surrey, Edmonton, and beyond.

## LAW ENFORCEMENT & GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

- **CBSA** | 446 investigations opened; 118 removal orders issued; 55 deportations completed as of 7 May 2026.
- **Police Task Forces** | Project AI-Extortion (Alberta), Operation Community Shield (Abbotsford), Peel Regional Police (17 arrests in related "For Brothers" gang on 26 May 2026).
- **National** | Terrorist designation enables enhanced asset freezes and investigative authorities.

## RISK ASSESSMENT & CLIENT IMPLICATIONS

**High-Risk Sectors** | South Asian-owned businesses (trucking/logistics, construction, hospitality), cultural/religious centres, and critical infrastructure partners with diaspora exposure.

**Proactive Indicators** | Unsolicited WhatsApp threats, sudden "Bishnoi/Brar" graffiti or social-media boasts, unusual surveillance near client sites.

**Spillover Potential** | Firearms trafficking and rapid recruitment via immigration pathways amplify risk.

1. **Immediate** | Scan recent WhatsApp communications; report any threats immediately to local extortion task forces and CBSA tip lines.

3. **Crisis Communications** | Pre-position denial-of-payment statements, community liaison scripts, and rapid-response media containment (Heimdall can activate 24/7).
